## He Aratohu maa te Kaiwhakamahi

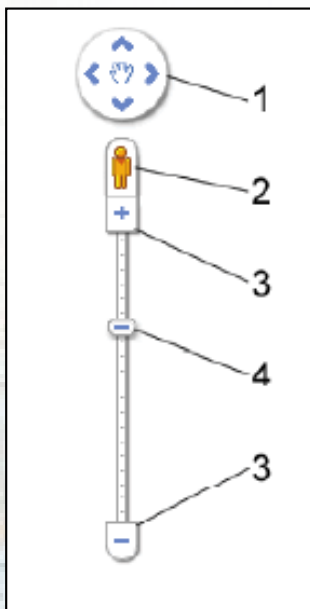

Kei te horopaki o Nga Mahere Google moo Ngaati Whanaunga ka whakaaturia te huhua o nga takotoranga whenua e whakahuatia ana i taa maatou paatere - Kei Whea Te Aute. Hei aawhina teenei tuinga i a koe ki te whakamahi i nga mahere Google moo Ngaati Whanaunga.

Ka aaei koe ki te whakaterere (te neke i too tirohanga) i roto i nga ahunga e rua i teeteahi mahere Google ahakoa teewhea. Hei roiroi (hei neke i te mahere) mahia teeteahi o eenei:

- Paawhiri, ka too ai i te mahere
- Peehingia te pere whakarunga i too papapaatuhi kia ahu whaka-te-raki
- Peehingia te pere whakararo i too papapaatuhi kia ahu whaka-te-tonga
- Peehingia te pere whaka-te-matau i too papapaatuhi kia ahu whaka-te-raawhiti
- Peehingia te pere whaka-te-mauui i too papapaatuhi kia ahu whaka-te-uru

I tua atu i teenei, ka aaei koe ki te topa mai, ki te topa atu raanei maa te peepahi i te kii +, i te kii - raanei. Nekehia te pehu ki teeteahi tauwaahi, ka whakamahi ai i te paatene panuku hei topa mai, hei topa atu raanei i taua tauwaahi. Kia tauwaenga, kia topa mai hoki ki teeteahi tauwaahi, paawhiri-ruatia te tauwaahi.

Te Tirohanga Tiriti - Paawhiritia kia kitea nga pikitia o te tiriti tonu

Topa - Paawhiritia + kia topa mai ki te tauwaenga o te mahere.  
Paawhiri - hei topa atu.

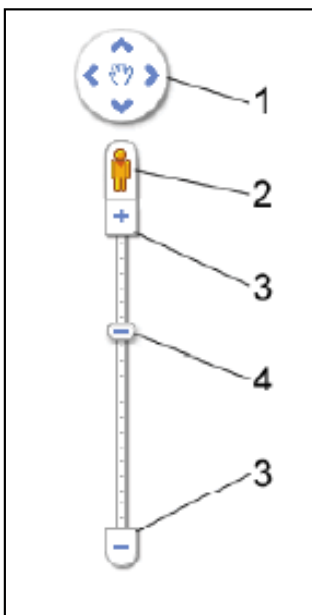
# Ngaati Whanaunga Google Maps ~ User Guide

Google Maps is an easy to use web-based GIS (Geographic Information System), which allows users to view mapped information and retrieve other information linked to particular features on a map. The Ngāti Whanaunga Google Map environment displays a range of geographic places that are referred to in our pātere - Kei Whea Te Aute.

This document will assist you in using the Ngāti Whanaunga Google maps. **NAVIGATING AROUND THE MAP WINDOW** You can navigate (move your view) in two dimensions on any Google Map. To pan (move the map), do one of the following:

- Click and drag the map
- Press the up arrow on your keyboard to move north
- Press the down arrow on your keyboard to move south
- Press the right arrow on your keyboard to move east
- Press the left arrow on your keyboard to move west

In addition, you can zoom in or out pressing the + or - keys. Move the cursor over a location and use the mouse scroll button to zoom in or out on that location. To center and zoom in on a location, double click the location.



## Using the Navigation Controls

The navigation controls you see at [maps.google.com](https://maps.google.com) are shown on the left. Navigation controls include:

1. Arrows - Click the appropriate arrow buttons to move the view north, south, east or west.
2. Street View - Click to view street-level imagery
3. Zoom - Click + to zoom in on the centre of the map. Click - to zoom out.
4. Zoom slider - Drag the zoom slider up or down to zoom in or out incrementally.
